Doras Luimní has a new look, and is now Doras! Our work often brings us to different parts of the country, and our name now reflects that. We are very much a Limerick based organisation, and the south/mid-west is our area of focus, but we are committed to helping International Protection Applicants and people from a migrant background wherever we can.

After almost two decades supporting people from a migrant background, we are determined to go into 2020, and a new decade, building on the amazing work done by all Doras staff in the past, taking on some of the same challenges, as well as new ones. Challenges such as; supporting the continuing need for International Protection Applicants to receive protection, improving conditions in Direct Provision and emergency accommodation in the short term/ending those institutions in the long term, easing paths to citizenship, advocating for adequate anti-racism law and generally ensuring that the rights of people from a migrant background are promoted and protected.

“It is important to reaffirm our goals and our voice, especially in the current climate in Ireland, where the far right is organising in earnest. Doras have been ensuring that migrants receive the support they need for a long time, and with the continuing need for people to seek protection in Ireland, that support is more necessary than ever.
